Luanda **Children with heart problems get treatment in Israel**

Luanda – A group of six Angolan children suffering from heart problems left this Wednesday for Israel, where they will be submitted to medical treatment, under the sponsorship of the LR Arte & Cultura association, through a project dubbed Save a Child's Heart.

Accompanied by their respective relatives, the children are aged between 0 to five years old. They will stay in Israel for about 45 days to two months, depending on the seriousness of each case.

The children have been selected by the David Bernardino Paediatric Hospital of Luanda.

The Save a Child's Heart project has already benefited 42 Angolan children aged between zero and sixteen, and it is part of a protocol signed between the Israeli group LR, which has been working in Angola for about 18 years, and the NGO Save a Child's Heart.
