Speaking to newsmen yesterday in Abuja, the Israeli Ambassador to Nigeria, Moshe Ram, said that the Israeli mission in Nigeria would identify children with such conditions and attended to them on a case by case basis within the available resources at

the embassy's disposal.

Ambassador Ram, who said that he was moved by the story of a three-year old boy, Master Mamufha Aiyebelehin, with a heart disease, noted that he could not just ignore such a situation.

He added that after reading the boy's story, he was moved to get in touch with an Israeli based foundation, Save A Child's Heart, who graciously accepted to assist the boy. ■
